

POLICE SERVICES PROGRAM

First Nations' self-administered Police Services have played an important role in many Aboriginal communities.

Police and security services face certain unique risks in their daily jobs. These risks require specialized insurance coverage for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage that may arise while performing their duties.

These coverages can include protection for:

- » False arrest
- » False imprisonment
- » Unlawful detention
- » Assault or battery, excessive use of force
- » Malicious prosecution
- » Libel, slander, defamation

The AIS program has unique coverage options for community police services including sworn officers, civilian employees, auxiliary officers, board members, Chief of Police and volunteers. All of the associated legal services are provided by lawyers who are experienced in First Nations policing matters.
